

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Various Roads, Yate, Little Stoke, Easter Compton and Falfield) (Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

This order is required in connection with carriageway patching works and will be operative from the 1 June 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **2 weeks** duration.

Schedule: Entire lengths of road unless otherwise stated

1. Barnwood Road, Yate
2. Braydon Avenue, Little Stoke
3. Love Lane, Easter Compton
4. Moorslade Lane, Falfield – which extends from its junction with Gloucester Road to the Gloucestershire County Boundary

Alternative routes: All vice versa

1. Rodford Way, Westerleigh Road, St Briavels Drive
2. Stoke Lane, Little Stoke Lane, Orpheus Avenue, Brook Way
3. Blackhorse Hill, Over Lane
4. A38 Gloucester Road, Lower Stone Road
