

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
**(Trench Lane, Bradley Stoke) (Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles, Foot
Passengers, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2020**

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Trench Lane which extends from its junction with Bowsand Way/Woodlands Lane roundabout in an easterly direction for a distance of 250 metres.

This order is required in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon bridge refurbishment works and will be operative from the 24 July 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **6 weeks** duration.
