On January 18th 2023 we received the unanimous support of the council to launch our exciting community project to commemorate the 30th anniversary of BSTC.

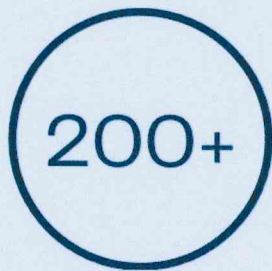
A collaborative mural, uniquely designed and produced by the residents of Bradley Stoke, to be installed on our council building on Savages Wood Rd.

Within 7 weeks the project had been completed and we are delighted with the results!

Over 200 Bradley Stoke Residents, ranging from 2yrs old to 87yrs old, have produced a stunning mural soaring across our council buildings. Beautifully balanced and unique, a true representation of our great town and its people.

Personal visits and workshops with all 7 local primary schools, our Secondary school, 7 pre schools, 3 local churches, 6 community groups and a drop in Saturday workshop attended by over 40 people has taken place during February, resulting in 40 beautiful mosaic birds being produced. Each one beautiful and unique. Hand grouted and finished, now installed in mesmerising flight, soaring towards our bright future.

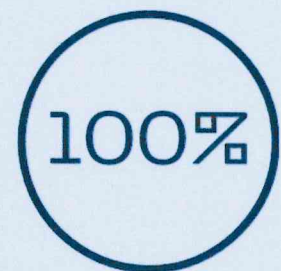
Impact Snapshot
