We are excited to invite any interested members of the public, especially those in our local community, to visit Winterbourne Medieval Barn to view the specialist repair work being carried out on one of the most important surviving medieval roof structures in the country.

Background of the project:

Major funding has been secured from The National Lottery Heritage Fund, with additional support from the Garfield Weston Foundation, to carry out urgent structural repairs to its 14th-century roof. The project will focus on the repair of a critically weakened roof truss dating from 1342.

During your visit you will be able to see how this work is progressing and find out more about the repairs that are taking place over a 2-month time period.
