BOWSLAND WAY

Works have progressed well on Bowsland Way and the road will reopen in both directions on Sunday 19 April.

PEAR TREE ROAD

20 TO 26 APRIL

Overnight closure of Pear Tree Road junction with Patchway Brook Roundabout for seven consecutive nights. No entry or exit from the roundabout to Pear Tree Road.

- **Time of work:** Overnight only, between 8pm and 6pm.
- **Purpose:** To prepare for the next stage of work, including the installation of safety barriers and temporary road markings.
- **Impact:** No impact on traffic during the day, however possibility of delays overnight (between 8pm and 6am). Diversion is via Woodlands Lane.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and vibrations expected.

27 APRIL TO JUNE 2026

Lane closure of Pear Tree Road (northbound only) at the junction of Patchway Brook Roundabout for the installation of the new footway, cycle track and crossing facilities.

- **Time of work:** Mainly daytime working, occasional overnight works.
- **Impact:** No access for vehicles from the roundabout to Pear Tree Road. Diversion in place via Woodlands Lane. Exit from Pear Tree Road to the roundabout is unaffected.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and vibrations expected.



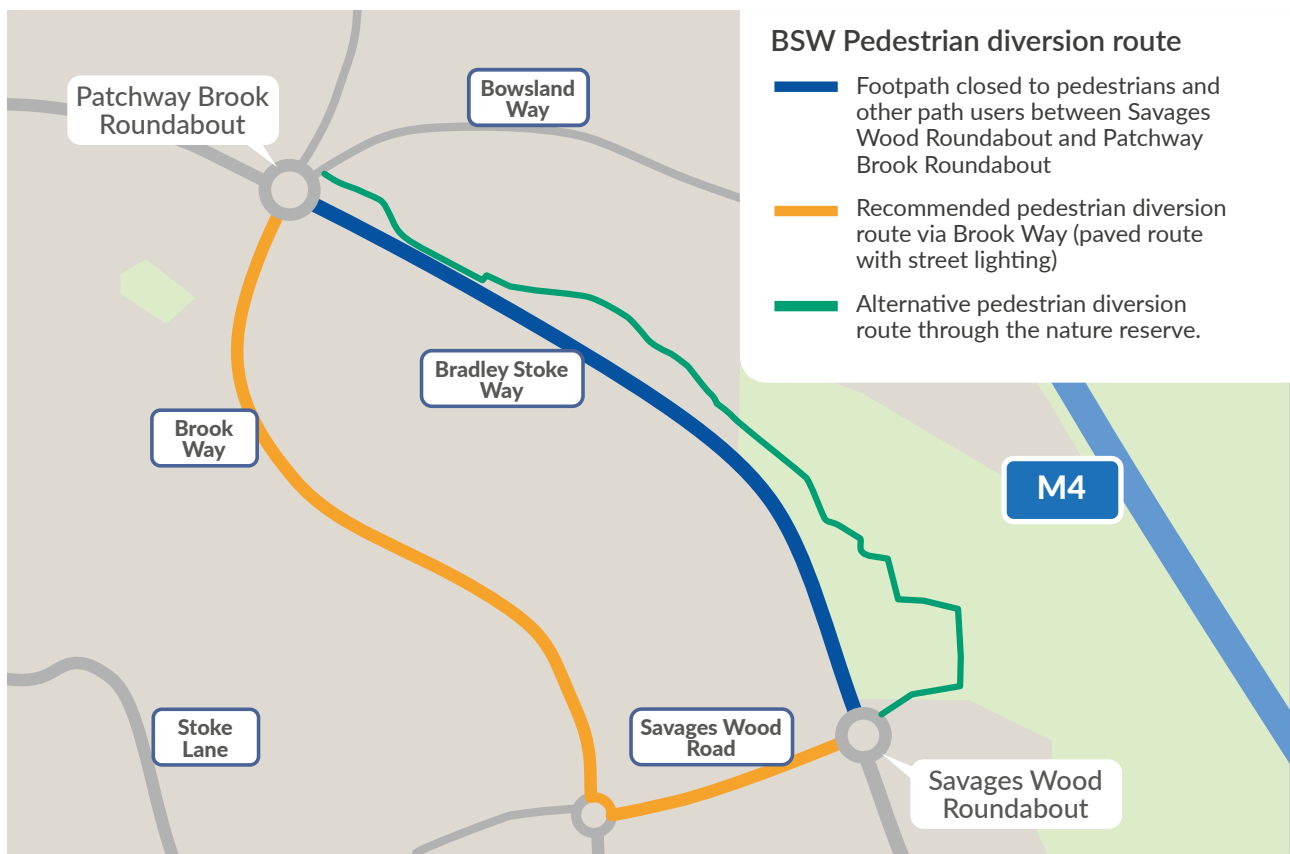
BRADLEY STOKE WAY

UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2026

Work is continuing along Bradley Stoke Way, between Savages Wood Roundabout and Patchway Brook Roundabout, for installation of a cycle track, new pedestrian footpath and upgraded crossing facilities.

Work is progressing well. We have started to apply the final surfacing to the newly constructed facilities and have started installing new crossing facilities along the route.

There is minimal impact on drivers as work is taking place within the bus lane. However, the pedestrian path will remain closed until September, with a recommended diversion route in place via Brook Way.



3 APRIL TO 19 APRIL

Overnight work (8pm to 6am) will continue on Bradley Stoke Way, between Savages Wood Roundabout and Patchway Brook Roundabout, until April 19. Please continue to use the signed diversion route whilst this work takes place.

SAVAGES WOOD ROAD

29 MARCH TO JUNE 2026

Work is continuing on Savages Wood Road which is closed eastbound at the junction of Savages Wood Roundabout for the installation of the footpath, cycle track and crossing.

- **Time of work:** Mainly daytime working, occasional overnight works.
- **Impact:** No vehicle access to the roundabout from Savages Wood Road (see map). Diversion in place via Brook Way. Exit from the roundabout to Savages Wood Road is unaffected.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and vibration expected.
