Important information about upcoming works in Bradley Stoke

A38, SOUTH OF AZTEC WEST ROUNDABOUT

7 TO 9 SEPTEMBER

Works: Full overnight closure of a section of the A38, south of Aztec West Roundabout for two consecutive nights (see map 1)

Time of works: Overnight only, between 8pm and 6am.

Purpose: To prepare for this stage of work, including lane narrowing and installation of safety barriers.

Impact: Limited impact on traffic during the day, however a signed diversion route will be in place overnight. Aztec West Roundabout will be open as normal during the works, aside for entry to the closed section.

Noise: Moderate noise and vibrations are expected.



9 SEPTEMBER TO DECEMBER

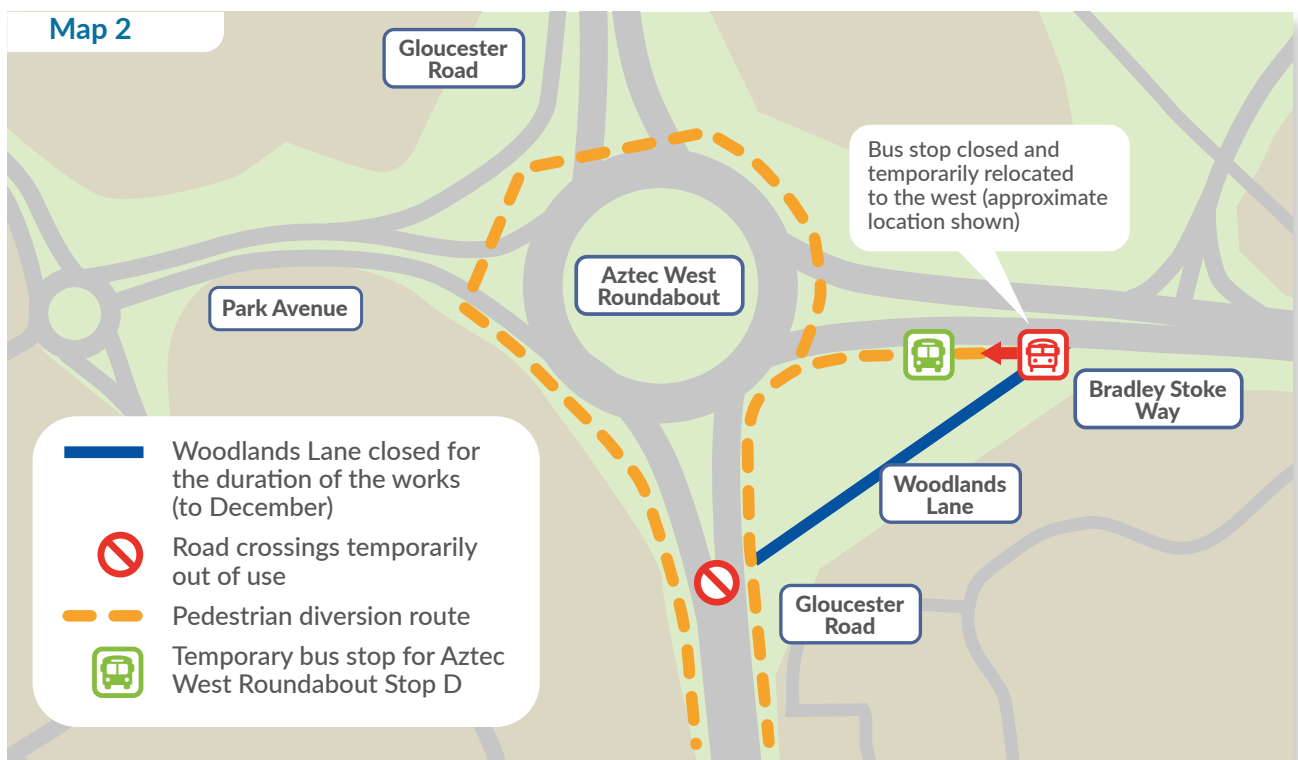
Works: Overnight lane closures on the section of the A38, south of Aztec West Roundabout as marked on the above map. Work is expected to continue until Christmas.

Time of works: Overnight only, between 8pm and 6am.

Purpose: Installation of footpath, cycle track and improved toucan crossing facilities.

Impact: Limited impact on traffic overnight as one northbound and southbound lane will remain in use. Minor overnight delays possible. The toucan crossing on the A38 south of Aztec West Roundabout will be closed for the duration of the works. A pedestrian diversion will be place, as shown on the map below (map 2).

Noise: Moderate noise and vibrations are expected.



PATCHWAY BROOK ROUNDABOUT TO AZTEC WEST ROUNDABOUT

9 TO 11 SEPTEMBER

Works: Full overnight closure of Bradley Stoke Way for two consecutive nights, between Patchway Brook Roundabout and Aztec West Roundabout (see map 1).

Time of works: Overnight only, between 8pm and 6am.

Purpose: To prepare for this stage of work, including lane narrowing and installation of safety barriers.

Impact: Limited impact on traffic during the day, however a signed diversion route will be in place overnight.

Noise: Moderate noise and vibrations are expected.

11 SEPTEMBER TO DECEMBER

Work will continue along Bradley Stoke Way, between Patchway Brook Roundabout and Aztec West Roundabout. This includes installation of a segregated cycle track, new pedestrian footpath and upgraded crossing facilities.

Time of works: Mainly daytime working, occasional overnight works.

Impact: Minimal impact expected for drivers as work takes place within the bus lane. However, the pedestrian path along the southern side of Bradley Stoke Way and Woodlands Lane will be closed until December. A pedestrian diversion will be in place.

Public transport: Aztec West Roundabout Stop D (westbound) at Woodlands Lane will be closed for the duration of the works. A temporary stop will be located on Bradley Stoke Way between Woodlands Lane and Aztec West Roundabout.

Noise: Moderate noise and vibrations are expected.
