### Important information about upcoming works in Bradley Stoke

- Bradley Stoke Way (between Savages Wood Roundabout and Patchway Brook Roundabout), **including additional overnight works in April**
- Savages Wood Roundabout
- Patchway Brook Roundabout

## BRADLEY STOKE WAY

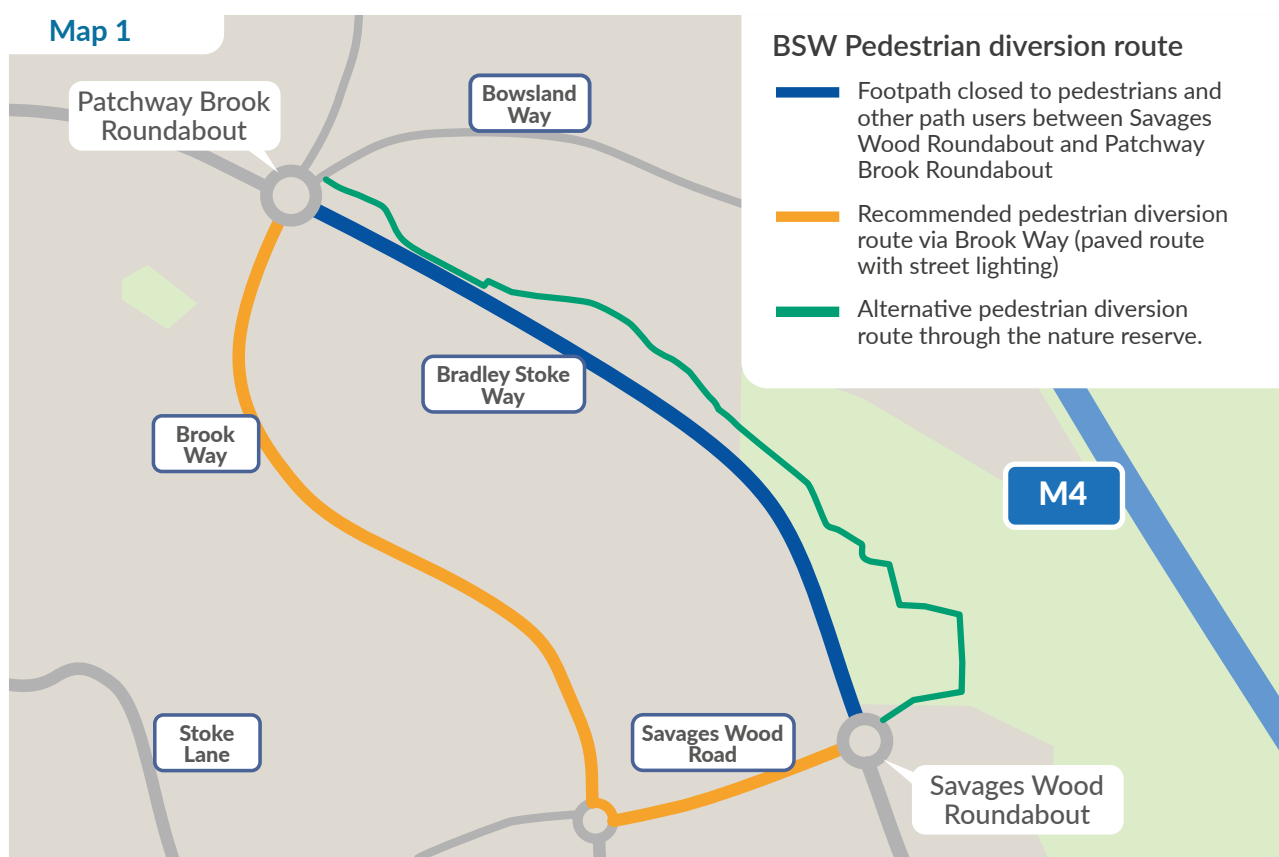
### UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2026

Work is continuing along Bradley Stoke Way, between Savages Wood Roundabout and Patchway Brook Roundabout, for installation of a cycle track, new pedestrian footpath and upgraded crossing facilities.

Work is progressing well. We will shortly start applying final surfacing to the newly constructed facilities, followed by installation of the new crossing facilities along the route.

There is minimal impact on drivers as work is taking place within the bus lane. However, the pedestrian path will remain closed until September, with a recommended diversion route in place via Brook Way.

### 3 APRIL TO 19 APRIL

Additional overnight works on Bradley Stoke Way, between Savages Wood Roundabout and Patchway Brook Roundabout.

- **Time of works:** Overnight only, 8pm to 6am.
- **Purpose:** To install new ducting under the carriageway for future traffic signal-controlled pedestrian crossings.
- **Impact:** No impact on traffic during the day, however road closed overnight (between 8pm and 6am). Diversion is via the A38 (see diversion map below).
- **Noise:** Significant noise and some vibrations are expected.

Additional overnight works on Bradley Stoke Way at Savages Wood Roundabout.

- **Time of works:** Overnight only, 8pm to 6am.
- **Purpose:** To continue with active travel works including resurfacing of the footway.
- **Impact:** No impact on traffic during the day, however possibility of delays overnight (between 8pm and 6am) as temporary traffic signals will be in operation.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and some vibrations are expected.



## SAVAGES WOOD ROAD

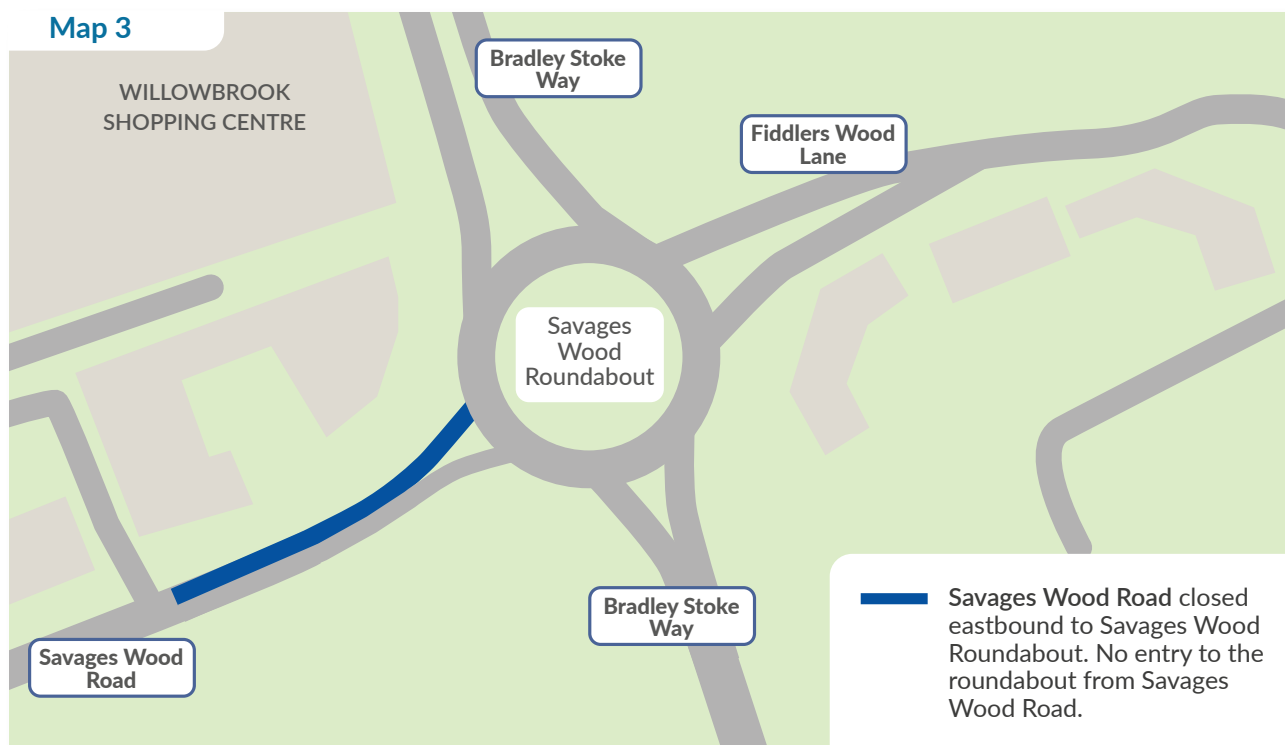
### 28 MARCH TO 30 MARCH

- **Works:** Overnight closure of Savages Wood Road junction with Savages Wood Roundabout for three consecutive nights. No entry or exit to the roundabout from Savages Wood Road.
- **Time of works:** Overnight only, between 8pm and 6am.
- **Purpose:** To switch the one-way system and prepare for the next stage of work, including installation of safety barriers.
- **Impact:** No impact on traffic during the day, however possibility of delays overnight (between 8pm and 6am). Diversion is via Brook Way.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and some vibrations are expected.

### 29 MARCH TO JUNE 2026

- **Works:** Closure of Savages Wood Road and footway (eastbound) at the junction with Savages Wood Roundabout for installation of footpath, cycle track and puffin crossing.
- **Time of work:** Mainly daytime working, occasional overnight works.
- **Impact:** No vehicle access to the roundabout from Savages Wood Road (see map). Diversion in place via Brook Way. Exit from the roundabout to Savages Wood Road is unaffected.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and vibration expected.

## BOWSLAND WAY

### UNTIL END OF APRIL

Bowsland Way remains closed (westbound) at the junction of Patchway Brook Roundabout for installation of footpath, cycle track and puffin crossing.

- **Time of work:** Mainly daytime working, occasional overnight works.
- **Impact:** No vehicle access to the roundabout from Bowsland Way. Diversion in place via Pear Tree Road, Woodlands Lane and Trench Lane. Entry to Bowsland Way from the roundabout from is unaffected.
- **Noise:** Moderate noise and vibrations expected.
